STRAP STRAP RECYCLING PROGRAM

FROMM PET strapping is made from 100% recycled resins. Sourcing high quality recycled resin, we are able to convert this into PET strapping used around the world for strapping things such as timber, bricks, cotton, and hay.

Australia, as a net importer of just about everything has traditionally used landfills as the face of waste removal from society. FROMM's PET strapping recovery program addresses one of the important parts of the sustainability chain and takes responsibility for what we create.

By leasing or purchasing a FROMM strap chopper, our customers can process used strapping into recyclable pieces. These devices reduce the material from bulky hard to handle lengths into small pieces that fit into 500KG bulk bags.

In our programme, the bulk bags when full of clean and uncontaminated chopped strap are sent to our facility for reprocessing where the material is granulated and processed into reusable resin. The recycled resin is used to manufacture all sorts of items, including "hand grade" PET strapping for other markets.

Strap must be sorted by colour in order to recycle. Various shades of green PET strap may be collected together. Black PET strap must be











collected in a separate bulk bag.

In the event of contamination (mixed colours or materials other than PET), the chopped strapping cannot be used and will go to landfill. Contaminating the product defeats the efforts of all of us, so it is important that only PET strapping is chopped up.
